

National Taiwan University of Science and Technology EMI Teaching Assistant Training and Reward Regulations

Approved at the 629th Administrative Meeting on April 9, 2024

1. The "National Taiwan University of Science and Technology EMI Teaching Assistant Training and Reward Regulations" (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) are hereby established by the National Taiwan University of Science and Technology (NTUST) with the aim to cultivate and enhance the competence and quality of English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI) teaching assistants, alongside the selection of outstanding and excellent teaching assistants.
2. The Regulations apply to EMI teaching assistants for EMI courses offered by NTUST, whose main task is to assist or carry out activities to enhance the quality of EMI teaching.
3. To serve as a teaching assistant in the EMI course, one must attend at least one EMI-related lecture/talk recognized by the Office of Bilingual Education Initiatives (hereinafter referred to as the OBEI) during the semester.
4. Those who wish to obtain certification as EMI teaching assistants recognized by the OBEI must also participate in two EMI teaching assistant training sessions announced and recognized by the OBEI during the semester. After obtaining certification, they are eligible to participate in the selection of Outstanding and Excellent EMI Teaching Assistants for EMI Courses (hereinafter referred to as the EMI TA selection).
5. Those interested in participating in the EMI TA selection for the current semester can apply directly if they have obtained the EMI teaching assistant certification for the semester. Those who already hold the EMI teaching assistant certification from previous semesters must additionally attend one of the EMI-related lectures/talks announced by the OBEI during the semester to be eligible for the EMI TA selection.
6. Individuals interested in participating in the EMI TA selection may only apply for one course per semester.
7. The EMI TA selection will be held once per semester, with the total number of outstanding and excellent teaching assistants not exceeding five percent of the total number of EMI teaching assistants for that semester.
8. Participants in the EMI TA selection must submit their applications and relevant materials to the OBEI before the announced deadline each semester. The applications will be reviewed by the OBEI committee.
9. Each outstanding EMI teaching assistant will receive an outstanding teaching assistant certificate and a reward of NT\$6,000, while each excellent EMI teaching

assistant will receive an excellent teaching assistant certificate and a reward of NT\$3,600.

10. The funding for the reward items in the Regulations shall be provided by The Program on Bilingual Education for Students in College and other related projects. The number and funding of awards for each year shall be determined based on the annual budget.
11. The Regulations shall be implemented after being approved by the NTUST Administrative Meeting and shall also apply to any amendments.
